Reasons

Reviews add value to every software implementation. By definition, an external specialist – who is not part of the project team is required to perform the review. An AVEVA specialist who is not involved in day-to-day activities of the project, visits your site as an independent and objective reviewer to assess its status and progress. The reviewer identifies potential risks to the success of the project and recommends corrective measures.

Participants

Key people participating in the implementation program, may include:

Options

For complete implementation projects it is recommended to perform the review at the end of each phase. In other cases, where the critical stages are at project start-up and at go-live, it is recommended to perform reviews at these stages.

Review Process

The project review service is an on-site consulting service. During the visit, the AVEVA specialist conducts interviews based on a questionnaire. The consultant then analyses the answers, and presents all findings and recommendations to you at the end of the review, in person, or if you prefer, in a written report.
